SAN LORENZO VALLEY FEMA ASSISTANCE

In partnership with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), the Santa Cruz County Emergency Operations Center is pleased to announce the availability of disaster recovery assistance in the San Lorenzo Valley.

On Monday and Tuesday, Sept. 14-15, FEMA will station a mobile assistance vehicle at Boulder Creek Elementary School, 400 W Lomond St., Boulder Creek. Assistance will be available from 9 a.m.-6 p.m. each day.

Applicants should be prepared with the following information if available:

- Social Security Number
- Insurance policy information
- Address of the damaged primary dwelling
- A description of disaster-caused damage and losses
- Current mailing address
- Current telephone number
- Total household annual income
- Routing and account number of your checking or savings account (for direct transfer to your bank account)
