C. ARRA grant programs – status

Johnson provided update on statewide AB811 pilot program, which now has 14 counties and 146 cities participating. California Energy Commission award will be determined in February 2010. Gordon reported on small county competitive EEBG program and deadlines. Sarris reported on possible grant funding for regional effort to establish electric vehicle charging stations at strategic locations.

During oral comments, Public member Matejcek addressed the Commission.
