NOTICE OF PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Resource Conservation District of Santa Cruz County (RCD) proposes the implementation of the South County Habitat Restoration Program (the Program). The comprehensive program includes the large-scale removal of eucalyptus within the 11,585 acre Program Area in South Santa Cruz County (South County) to reduce the risk of catastrophic wildfire and property damage and the restoration of native habitat to aid the recovery of the Santa Cruz long-toed salamander (SCLTS) and other endemic wildlife. This project will be considered at a public hearing by the Planning Commission. The time, date, and location have not been set. When scheduling does occur, these items will be included in all public hearing notices for the project.




Figure 1 Program Location
