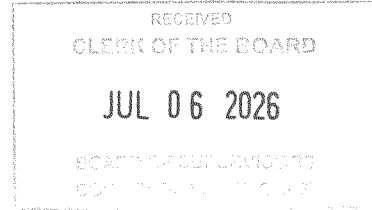


**Project Description:**

The approved project includes amendments to the Big Basin Redwoods State Park (BBRSP) General Plan and the adoption of the Reimagining BBRSP Facilities Management Plan. The approved General Plan amendments include text changes to provide clarity consistent with the 2013 General Plan. The Facilities Management Plan is designed to guide stewardship, management, and use of existing and future facilities consistent with the 2013 General Plan. The approved project includes facilities and improvement guidance for 19 identified sites in the five zones in the Focus Area.

This Notice of Determination is to advise that the California Department of Parks and Recreation  Lead Agency has approved the above-described project on July 2, 2026, and has made the following determinations:

1. The project  will have a significant effect on the environment.
2.  An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program  was not adopted for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was adopted for this project.
