duly seconded by Supervisor Hernandez
the following resolution is adopted:

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING THE REGIONAL INTEROPERABLE NEXT
GENERATION (RING) RADIO SYSTEM ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz and its public safety partner agencies, including the City of Santa Cruz, City of Watsonville, City of Capitola, City of Scotts Valley, and the University of California, Santa Cruz have a shared and compelling interest in maintaining a comprehensive, interoperable public safety communications system to serve the needs of fire, law enforcement, emergency medical services, education, and other public safety and municipal functions within Santa Cruz County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Santa Cruz and its partner agencies have entered into the Master Service and Governance Agreement (MSGA) for the Regional Interoperable Next Generation (RING) Radio System to establish the legal and operational framework for a next-generation trunked P25 regional radio system; and

WHEREAS, the RING Radio System represents a critical investment in public safety infrastructure, providing interoperability among all public safety disciplines throughout Santa Cruz County, and its effective governance requires structured oversight, technical expertise, and broad stakeholder participation; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Committee, as defined in the MSGA, is established as the governing body of the RING Radio System, composed of one executive or designee from each Member Agency, to provide strategic oversight, recommend budgets, set Capital and Operational Fees, and make policy and financial recommendations concerning the operation, management, and capital planning of the RING Radio System; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds it necessary and appropriate to formally establish the RING Radio System Advisory Committee pursuant to Santa Cruz County Code (SCCC) 2.38.070, authorize County participation in said governance body, and direct the County Executive Officer to take all actions necessary to implement the governance framework as set forth in the MSGA; and

WHEREAS, effective governance of the RING Radio System will promote regional collaboration, ensure fiscal accountability, maintain technical excellence, and advance the public safety communications capabilities of all residents and agencies within Santa Cruz County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors hereby formally establishes the RING Radio System Advisory Committee consisting of the RING Executive Committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RING Executive Committee shall serve as the primary governing and oversight body of the RING Radio System, composed of one executive-level representative or designee from each Member Agency pursuant to the MSGA.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RING Radio System Advisory Committee's purpose is to provide strategic oversight, recommending budgets, setting Capital and Operational Fees, and making policy and financial recommendations concerning the operation, management, and capital planning of the RING Radio System.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RING Radio System Advisory Committee shall terminate two (2) years after adoption by the Santa Cruz County Board of Supervisors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the RING Radio System Advisory Committee's organization and procedures are specified in the MSGA and shall be consistent with SCCC 2.38.110 through 2.38.250.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors authorizes the County Executive Officer, or designee, to appoint the County's representative to the RING Executive Committee and to take all other administrative actions necessary to implement and operationalize the governance structure established by this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors is directed to deliver a certified copy of this Resolution to the County Executive Officer, the Director of Information Services, all Member Agency representatives, and such other parties as may be appropriate.

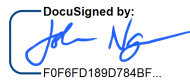
