September 2025 Tsunami Event: Impacts were negligible but was a good opportunity to practice Countywide coordination. Cancelled junior guard programs, state and national level learnings with National Tsunami Warning Center and Wireless Emergency Alerts.

Measure Q: \$2.5 million in annual competitive grantmaking; \$100k per supervisorial district; plus fixed allocations for cities and agencies. Vision Plan nearing completion.
