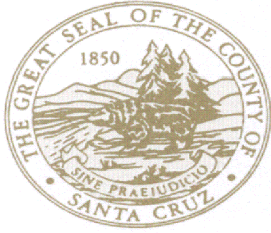

- Develop a timeline to continue collaborative planning to outline next steps in exploring LRP opportunities
