FIRST YOUTH ADVISORY TASK FORCE CONVENED

The County of Santa Cruz is pleased to announce membership of the inaugural Youth Advisory Task Force, bringing together 23 area youth who live, work or go to school in the county.

The Youth Advisory Task Force held its first meeting Monday and will explore issues facing local youth and make findings and recommendations related to youth engagement in local government. The Task Force is the result of the "A Santa Cruz County Like Me" initiative, which aims to diversify the age, class, racial/ethnic, gender, geographic representation, educational attainment, and other demographic profiles of the approximately 35 County commissions and committees to better reflect the community.

In all, the County received 75 applications for the Youth Advisory Task Force, far exceeding expectations and demonstrating that local youth seek to be more engaged in important issues facing their community. Task Force members range in age from 14 to 24 and were selected from neighborhoods and schools throughout the county. The Youth Advisory Task Force will meet monthly through October 2025.
