### **SANTA CRUZ COUNTY YOUTH CIVICS SUMMIT REINFORCES CIVIC LEARNING AND TRUSTED ELECTION ENGAGEMENT**

On February 27, 2026, high school students from across the County will gather at Cabrillo College for the 2026 Santa Cruz County Youth Civics Summit. Led by Tricia Webber, County Clerk and Registrar of Voters, and in partnership with the Santa Cruz County Office of Education, United Way of Santa Cruz County, and Cabrillo College, the Summit offers students dynamic, nonpartisan civic learning experience.

- Engage with local public officials
- Participate in a mock election
