COUNTY BEGINS ANNUAL ROAD MAINTENANCE PROGRAM WITH TARGETED SPOT PAVEMENT REPAIRS IN MID-COUNTY

April 27, 2026 – Santa Cruz, CA – The County of Santa Cruz Department of Community Development & Infrastructure (CDI) is beginning its annual road maintenance program work in mid-county now through June 18, 2026, focusing on targeted spot pavement repairs.

Every year, the County sequences its annual road maintenance program during the drier months, when conditions are best for effective spot paving, allowing crews to address the most deteriorated sections of roadway.

This work will include the following locations:

- **Laurel Road:** Near Redtail Ridge, April 27 – May 4
- **Skyland Road:** Various locations, May 5 – May 12
- **Miller Hill Road:** Between Silver Mountain Drive and Miller Cutoff Road, May 13 – May 14
- **Stetson Road:** Between Miller Hill Road and Comstock Mill Road, May 18 – May 22
- **Redwood Lodge Road:** Between Tall Tree Hill and Soquel San Jose Road, May 26 – May 28
- **Morrell Road:** Near address area 23700, June 1 – June 2
- **Long Ridge Road:** Various locations along the roadway, June 3 – June 5
- **41st Avenue:** Between Melton Street and Bain Avenue, June 8 – June 10
- **Happy Valley Road:** Spot repair work, June 11
- **Chanticleer Avenue:** Between Soquel Drive and Portola Drive, June 15 – June 18

Work will take place on weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. Traffic control will be in place, and commuters should expect brief delays in active work zones.

In addition to spot paving, CDI road crews will continue routine work such as vegetation management, drainage clearing, and filling potholes throughout the season.
