**COUNTY OF SANTA CRUZ COMPLETES 17 MILES OF ROADWAY REPAVING**

August 27, 2024 – Santa Cruz, CA – Today, the County of Santa Cruz Department of Community Development & Infrastructure presented the annual 2016 Measure D Notice of Completion to the Board of Supervisors.

As part of the Measure D 5-Year Plan previously approved by the Board, the County is focusing on resurfacing neighborhood and local access roads to improve pavement conditions throughout the county. The latest update showcases the successful repaving of approximately 17 miles of roadways in 2023 as part of the 2023 Pavement Management Project, primarily funded by Measure D Sales Tax Funds, in addition to GreenWaste Fees, State Transportation Improvement Program funds, and Regional Surface Transportation Program Exchange grants.

Approved by 67.78% of Santa Cruz County voters in 2016, Measure D supports improving, operating, and maintaining the County's transportation network, including local roadway pavement repair and operational improvements, school and neighborhood traffic safety projects, and bicycle/pedestrian projects.
