END-OF-YEAR UPDATE: GREEN VALLEY ROAD MULTI-USE PROJECT

December 10, 2024 – Santa Cruz, CA – The County of Santa Cruz Department of Community Development & Infrastructure is pleased to share the latest progress on the Green Valley Road Multi-Use Project.

The Green Valley Road Multi-Use Project will provide pedestrians with a safer, more accessible path through the area. The project also includes upgraded road crossings, new bus shelters, landscaping, and public art installations.

Current work includes the intersection of Amesti Road and Green Valley Road. While the intersection temporarily combines the left and right turn lanes for vehicles turning onto Green Valley Road, this temporary change is necessary to accommodate ongoing construction, and both left and right turn lanes will be restored as the project nears completion.

Funded by the Clean California Grant and 2016 Measure D, this project is on track to be completed Spring 2025. For more information about this project, visit: <https://www.sccroads.org/>.
